



- > Routes Selected:
 - ➤ Loyola/UPT to Canal St.
 - > French Quarter/Press St. Loops
 - Riverfront/Convention Center















Loyola Corridor – Fast Facts

- ➤ Route is .8 miles (1.6 double Track)
- ➤ 4 Near Side Station Stops 60' Platforms – All ADA accessible
 - > UPT
 - > Julia St.
 - Poydras St.
 - > Tulane
- ➤ Will use the existing Red Car Fleet
- Key Milestone Dates
 - Start of Construction July 2011
 - ➤ Revenue Service late June 2012





Station Design

- Stations are being designed as LEED Compliant
 - Solar Powered Lighting
 - Roofing Material must have integrated solar lighting
- Simplified Station designs
 - Clearly identifiable as Streetcar Stop
 - ➤ Easily repairable
 - ➤ Meets FTA safety and security standards
- > Stations will have video kiosks
 - ➤ Next Streetcar
 - > Advertising
 - ➤ Safety information



- ➤ Currently Completing Environmental Documents
- ➤ Project RTA Bond financed
 - ➤ Completion of EA
 - >Final Design
 - **≻**Construction
- >Key elements
 - >Fully Expandable
 - ➤ Similar design elements as Loyola Corridor






Rampart/St. Claude

- > Route is 1.55 miles (3.05 double track)
- ➤ Will use the existing Red Car Fleet
- > Key Milestone Dates
 - Final Design Start July, 2011
 - ➤ Start of Construction late 2nd QTR 2012
 - ➤ Revenue Service 3rd QTR 2013











Riverfront/Convention Center

- ➤ Currently in EA/PE Phase
- ➤ No funding source identified at present
- ➤ Candidate for Small Starts Funding
- ➤ Key elements
 - ➤ Circulator connector
 - ➤ Ties Riverfront/Canal St.
 - ➤ Key tie in for convention ridership
