About the Course

This one-day training session is designed to provide local and rural agencies with practical and effective ways to incorporate safety solutions in their day-to-day activities and in the project development process.

The workshop focuses on processes for incorporating safety into all aspects of local and rural road activities, and on making safety a priority through inclusion in the traditional decision -making process, 365 days a year. The course illustrates how safety can be integrated into rural/ local transportation project development at all stages, including planning, programming, design, construction, operations, and maintenance, and offers an overview of the network screening process using available local crash data. Through practical exercises and facilitator-led discussions, emphasis is placed on operations maintenance to reflect the predominant, day-today responsibilities of rural/local transportation agencies. The benefits and potential cost savings of safety initiatives are discussed using examples from rural/local agencies.

Who Should Attend

This program is designed for all public works directors, road and highway supervisors and foremen, transportation engineers, planners, and other safety professionals. Participants will learn practical ways to "read the road" to improve safety and save lives!
