- TRB State Reps annually requested to submit nominations to committees that are "rotating" membership
 - Will be doing this even earlier in the future
- Tools implemented to enhance participation by those who find it difficult to travel to meetings

State DOT Involvement In Standing Committees Has Increased!

- TRB Standing Committees collectively have almost 800 State DOT employees as members in 2013
- Highest number in recent memory
- This despite decrease in overall size of State DOT workforces, and travel restrictions
