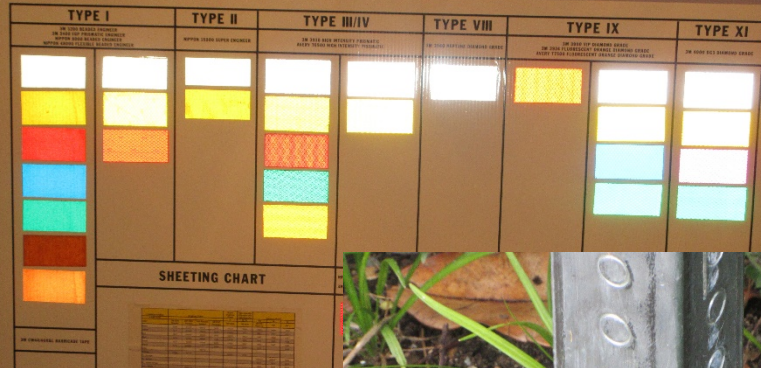

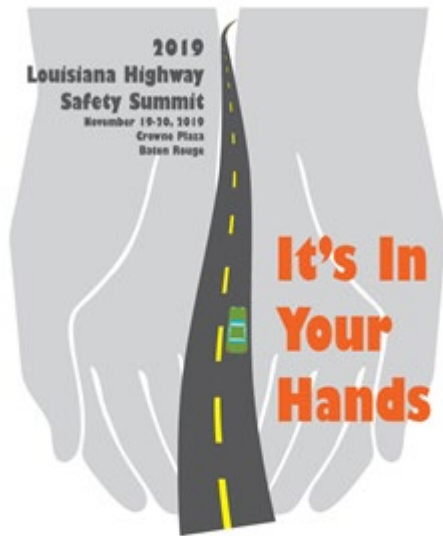
Succession Planning and Servant Leadership

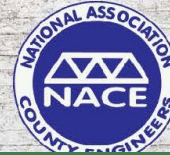
