

Public Works Infectious Disease Enhanced Precautions

Enhanced Cleaning Efforts

- Disinfection of all surfaces in public areas every 2 hours
- Disinfection of all areas in PW facilities twice daily

Good Hygiene Practices

- Daily safety briefings to include self-assessment of health
- PPE to include masks, hand sanitizer, and rubber gloves

Good Management Practices

- Only disseminate verifiable information from CDC or approved source
- Ensure employees have all necessary supplies for enhanced precautions



Public Works Operational Precautions

COVID Directive 2 3/16/2020

Public Works Operational Precautions

Four-day work weeks

- Allows more time for personal health assessments
- Allows more time for infected surfaces to become safe again

Tolerances for Tardiness

• +/- 10 mins to workday to allow for 1 person at time clocks at a time

Meeting restrictions

- All business to be handled via phone conference or email string (pre-Zoom).
- Prohibited any congregating in any facility including break rooms.

Emergency Strategic Staffing Protocol(ESSP)

"The Emergency Strategic Staffing Protocol (ESSP) is to mitigate workforce depletion due to worker fatigue and/or illness, and to ensure labor readiness in the event of a prolonged emergency scenario."

Emergency Strategic Staffing Protocol (ESSP)

General Operations

- Each division would divide itself into 2 teams (Alpha and Bravo)
- Teams should mirror each other in skills and resources as close as possible
- One team will work two weeks (80 hrs) while the other team is on reserve time
 - Reserve time is still paid regular time.

Emergency Strategic Staffing Protocol (ESSP)

General Operations

- Employees on reserve time are considered "on the clock" and must be available to respond
 within an hour of notification.
 - Vacations and scheduled time off cannot be used during ESSP activation.
 - All sick days will require doctor's note.

- Four full activations of Emergency Operations Centers for Tropical Systems
- Three partial activations of EOC for excessive rainfall events
