
## Concrete Overlays - Introduction

- Concrete overlays have been successfully constructed in at least 45 different states









# Adoption of Bonded vs. Unbonded Historically, Mostly on Concrete





### Bonded Overlay on Concrete: Keys to Success

- Concrete Bonding is important
- Concrete aggregate used in overlay should have thermal properties similar to that of existing pavement
- Matching joints with underlying pavement allows structure to move monolithically.
- Existing joints must be in fair condition or be repaired
- Timing of joint sawing is important
- Cut transverse joints full depth +1/2" and longitudinal joints at T/2.
- Width of transverse joint of overlay to be equal to or greater than underlying crack width of the existing pavement.
- Curing should be timely and adequate






# Bonded Over Asphalt/Composite Keys to Success





- Bonding is critical
- Small square panels reduce curling, warping, & shear stresses in bond.
- •Mill to remove surface distresses, or improve bonding.
- ■Be sure to leave 3" or more of HMA after milling.
- •Avoid placing longitudinal overlay joints in the wheel paths.
- Application of curing compound is critical.
- Joint sealing







### **Unbonded Overlay of Concrete Pavements**



Keys to Success



- Full-depth repairs only where structural integrity is lost at isolated spots.
- Separation layer (normally 1" asphalt or geotextile fabric)
- Use to restore structural capacity of the existing pavement and increase pavement life equivalent to fulldepth pavement
- Faulting of 3/8 in. or less in the existing concrete pavement
- Shorter joint spacing helps minimize curling and warping stresses
- No need to match joints with those of the underlying concrete pavement




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


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


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


# Unbonded Over Asphalt/Composite Keys to Success





- Milling to eliminate surface distortions of 2 in. or more
- Complete repairs at isolated spots where structural integrity needs to be restored



 Partial bonding between the overlay and the existing asphalt pavement is acceptable and may even improve load-carrying capacity



































# Benefits of Concrete Overlays

- Concrete overlays cost-effectively extend pavement life and improve both functional and structural characteristics.
- Are an effective means to enhance pavement sustainability by improving:
  - surface reflectance (albedo),
  - increasing structural longevity,
  - enhancing surface profile stability and maintaining ride quality.



# CP.

#### 2015 Overlay Cost Survey


- Based on 31 projects in 7 states
- Includes concrete materials, placement and jointing
- Excludes pre-overlay repairs and separation layer if used
- 2015 avg. among 7 states = \$3.45 / SY/ in.
- 2010 avg. among 6 states = \$2.99 /SY/ in.
