# **EDC-1 Status and Successes**

## **Selected Initiatives:**

- Clarifying the Scope of Preliminary Design
  - Updated Manuals & Fully Implemented
- Safety Edge
  - > Adopted in the Florida Greenbook
- Prefabricated Bridge Elements & System (PBES)
  - > Decision Framework in Design Manual & Process
- ➤ Geosynthetic Reinforced Soil/ Integrated Bridge System
  - ➤ Developed Standard Details & Policy



# **EDC-1 Status and Successes**

## **Implemented Initiatives:**

- Mitigation Banking
  - Established by Florida Legislature in 1994
- > In-lieu Fees
  - Established by Florida Legislature in 1996
- Planning & Environmental Linkages
  - Projected Net Savings: \$26.1M / 67 years
- Flexibilities in ROW
  - Fully utilized
- Flexibilities in Utility Relocation
  - Fully utilized



# **EDC-1 Status and Successes**

- CMGC (FDOT's CM @ Risk)
  - Projects: 8
- Design Build
  - Projects: 438
  - ➤ Total Cost: \$11.6 B Ave. 29.5% of all funding
- Warm Mix Asphalt
  - Fully Implemented, 1,133,000 Tons 96 Projects
- Adaptive Signal Control
  - > Implemented since the 1990's
